

TIRANNA WAY SAILING VENUE DEFINITIONS

LAUNCHING AREA:

The Launching area is defined as the land on the Eastern side of the lakes waters out into the water to where a boat would run aground.

(Skippers may briefly leave the Control Area to go from and to the Launching Area to do such things as launching, adjusting, repairing, removing entangled objects (which would include another boat) etc as per Rule E4.5. Skippers actively racing may not man a rescue vessel that is outside the Launching Area, nor may skippers wade or swim out beyond the Launching Area. Note that however, competitors who are not racing are allowed in the rescue vessel that is outside the Launching Area.

Boats outside this area may only be retrieved by the rescue boat crew.

CONTROL AREA

The Control Area shall be from the edge of the lawned area and to the red markers as defined on Race Day.

Sailors are not to obstruct the pathway with antennae's and themselves at any time.
